

# Emergency paediatric first aid (QA level 3 award)



*Designed for individuals caring for children, this course offers delegates an understanding of basic first aid for babies and children.*

## Overview

**1 day, maximum of 12 delegates per course**

The aim of the qualification is to enable learners to attain the knowledge and practical competencies needed to deal with a range of paediatric first aid situations.

## Outcome

Delegates will be able to demonstrate the practical administration of safe, prompt, effective first aid in situations which arise when looking after children including unconscious casualty, bleeding, respiratory disorders, shock and anaphylaxis. This course caters for higher risk environments.

## Who should attend?

Anyone who works with or cares for children and requires basic first aid knowledge and skills.

**Note:** This qualification does not fulfil Ofsted's first aid requirement for early years teachers, nursery workers and child minders (as defined within the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage 2014 and within The Child Care Register guide).
